Summer Staff

This part of our team is the only group to stay the entire summer. Summer Staff is the integral backbone of Summer Camp making sure everything runs smoothly. This tight knit crew is responsible for duties like activities, meals, and worship. These people not only have a heart for the Lord and share his love with the lost, but also a heart for people with special needs and providing them with the time of their life at summer camp. Summer Staffers #1 job is to lead the CIA Team by example by investing in both the lives of the CIA team members and the lives of campers.

Salary Guarantee

Fundraising is a key portion of ministry at Kingdom Ranch. It allows us to invite others to be a part of the ministry here through encouragement, prayer, and funding. We ask that each Summer Staff member contact at least 50 contacts to raise a minimum of \$700 for his or her salary. The Summer Staff Team

*****Must be at least 16 YEARS OF AGE to qualify to be a Summer Staff member. If you do not meet this requirement, your application will be denied. *****

The Summer Staff Team is comprised of many people who are all called by God to be a part of the program at Kingdom Ranch. Below you will find information about the different positions where you may be used to bring the message of Jesus Christ to our campers. The positions for participants are:

According to the available Summer Staff and particular skill sets, positions may rotate or duplicate by need. You may also be responsible for assisting in other activities, programs or roles. Please come with a great work ethic, willingness to work, and the ability to be flexible with whatever camp delivers. Summer Staff's motto is "We will go until our WITS end", (Whatever It TakeS).

MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS: Registered Nurses or Licensed Physicians are used for each week of camp. Please contact us prior to completion of your application if you are interested in being camp nurse for one or more weeks of camp.

MEDICAL ASSISTANT: Medical assistant is a job for someone who feels comfortable in the medical field, yet may not be licensed or a registered nurse. Their job is to assist the Camp nurse in administering medicine and attending to any medical situations throughout the week of camp.

LEAD COUNSELOR: All our campers will have a CIA counselor member with them all week 1:1 with special needs and 1:5 with their siblings. The Lead Counselor will be responsible for setting the tone and leading by example. This person will also be the first to address any issues that may arise within campers or counselors. This person needs a high level of energy to get the crowd excited and longevity above most to maintain a fun filled and positive atmosphere throughout all weeks of camp. This person will also be responsible for leading the counselor's meeting each night, before their free time.

COOK & Kitchen Staff: The Kingdom Ranch Cook will be in charge of the kitchen. You will follow a set menu and organize the Kitchen Staff. Together you will prepare all the meals and service line. This person will be responsible for announcing the meal and will be the head leadership in the Kitchen for other Staff members and CIA assistants. The Kitchen Staff's job usually consists of chopping, stirring, and cleaning in the kitchen. Real gourmet skills are not necessary, just a great work ethic and desire to serve others. These team members will report to the Cook.

ACTIVITY LEADER(S): The Kingdom Ranch is packed with fun filled and exciting activities throughout the day that range from our ropes course and paddle boats to themed parties and kickball. The activities leader will be in charge of scheduling who will be leading what activities each day. Activities will include things like archery, crafts, ropes course, paddle boats, fishing, horseback riding, etc. The list of activities and available leaders will be different each week based on our CIA's and our campers.

WORSHIP LEADER(S): Sharing the message of Christ is the primary goal during Summer Camp at Kingdom Ranch. We strive to show that in all areas of camp, but the worship time will be the spiritual backbone of camp. The Worship leader will be responsible for leading everyone at camp in song and worship. This person's job will also include the organization and scheduling of the "order of service". Worship times may include, but is not limited to songs by instruments or preformed through sign language, skits, prayer, and a message. Camp's theme should be carried out moderately throughout each worship time and will be capped by the message delivered by the Camp Director. All Staff, CIA's, and volunteers may take a part in the worship time, but will report to the Worship Leader.

MAINTENANCE/ LANDSCAPING LEADER(S): Keeping camp looking nice throughout the summer is a tough job, but for those who want to get their hands dirty and help keep things running at camp, this is the job for you. The Maintenance Leader will be given a list of daily/weekly routine maintenance such as mowing, weed-eating, bathroom cleaning, etc. This person will be responsible for organizing each project and making sure that they get done safely with the proper equipment and protection. There will be a group of CIA's available to help each week that will report to the Maintenance Leader.

Kingdom Ranch - 2017 Policies

Statement of Faith: We believe God Almighty to be our creator and heavenly Father and His son Jesus Christ to be our Lord and Savior. We also believe the Holy Bible to be His inspired word and as such, is our final authority for faith and life. We do not condone the abuse of drugs, profanity, alcohol, and tobacco, as we believe that it is not in accordance with God's word. It is our purpose to teach His word and to glorify Him in all we do.

Kingdom Ranch is excited to invite new people in to the family of committed Christians who want to further the message of Jesus Christ. We want you to feel a part of our camp family and realize that we strive to glorify Jesus Christ in everything we do. We especially want the campers to see our staff and CIA's as living examples of Christ's life. In keeping with that, we have specific policies that we have stated below to allow you to understand what we believe is right and true in the eyes of our Lord.

If you do not agree with the policies of Kingdom Ranch, it is important that you let us know. The decisions you make personally about such issues are between you and God. However, as a representative of Kingdom Ranch we ask that you uphold and stand firm on these issues. If any are not abided, the liable party must have a meeting with the Kingdom Ranch directors with the possibility of being sent home. We take them very seriously and ask you do the same. Please read these policy statements carefully and sign your applications only if you agree to uphold them:

Policy:

- 1. <u>Alcohol, Illegal Drugs and Tobacco</u>: Our staff does not condone or personally use illegal drugs or tobacco. We do not condone the abuse of alcohol or allow for public drunkenness.
- 2. <u>Sexual Behavior</u>: We believe that premarital sex and homosexual relationships are in violation of God's word.
- 3. <u>Appearance & Dress Code</u>: While we know that God does not judge man by appearances, He looks at the heart, we still feel convicted to present a clean cut appearance on the outside, as well as the inside. Men MUST groom daily. You may keep your facial hair if you come to camp with a beard or mustache that is well groomed. However, you may not grow a new beard or mustache while at camp. Hair length is optional however males with long hair must keep it in a ponytail. All hair must be well groomed at all times.

T-shirts should reflect a Christian image and not have inscriptions or advertising for questionable products (i.e. beer products, slanderous sayings). No spaghetti strap or tight fitting shirts. Shirts must cover abdomen even when hands are lifted in the air.

Shorts must be loose fitting and have a 5in. inseam. No "Daisy Duke" style shorts. No words across the seat. Shoes must be worn at all times unless at water activities. Close-toed shoes are required during all daytime activities. Sandals and flip-flops may be worn to the nightly parties.

SWIMSUITS: Males trunks only (NO SPEEDOS). Females must wear modest one piece swimsuits, two-piece swimsuits will be permitted provided they **completely** cover the abdomen area even with hands in the air.

- 4. <u>Tattoos & Body Piercing</u>: While at camp all body piercing jewelry is to be removed. ONLY small studs on pierced ears may be worn by either sex. For safety reasons, NO naval, eyebrow or tongue jewelry will be worn at camp by CIA's or Staff. At the discretion of the camp directors any tattoo that may be viewed as inappropriate will need to be covered at all times. You are an example of a Christian lifestyle to your campers. Parents count on you to represent a clean-cut example. If discussions occur about tattoos or body piercing with campers or other participants, PLEASE try to steer the conversation in another direction and do not encourage campers or other participants to get tattoos or a body piercing.
- <u>Cell Phones & Laptop Computers</u>: In the world of high technology we have to make policy for electronic use.
 During camp terms, the use of cell phones or PC's are NOT permitted! Laptops are not to be brought to camp for use. No e-mails, text messages, etc. are to be sent or received on any device while you are on duty.
- 6. **Participation in Activities**: It is highly important that all staff is willing and able to participate in <u>all</u> activities. Activities include ropes course, climbing wall, paddleboats, water games, field games, horseback riding, fishing, rifle / archery range, and exposure to various farm animals. You will be exposed to the sun, heat, and a very vigorous, but rewarding schedule.
- 7. **Profanity & Gossip:** Profanity and gossip are unacceptable at camp. The Bible speaks strongly against both of these issues. By participating in or allowing gossip and profanity to spread, we hurt each other and take away from the purpose we are serving at camp. We will not tolerate any gossip or profanity. If you have something to say about a person at camp, you need to go directly to that person or to one of the directors.
